Summer Reading BINGO

Instructions:

Summer Reading BINGO is to be played all summer to encourage reading in a fun way for FBA students entering 1st through 3rd grades!



To play, students Complete a summer reading activity and then Color in the square when it's finished. (An adult needs to initial in the corner box of each space as the activity is Completed.) To get a BINGO, five in a row (vertical, horizontal, or diagonal) must be completed. Have students try for a Blackout BINGO and complete all the activities! Have fun reading this summer! ©

***NOTE: 2 of the spaces on the BINGO board are required assignments for every student for a graded summer reading activity at the beginning of the school year. Students need to have these books in hand when school begins in August.

Prizes:

- Any participation beyond 'Required Summer Reading assignments" earns an upgraded dog tag necklace for Kickin' It Math Facts!
- Earn a Book Buck for every BINGO you complete! Cash these in at the Summer Reading Store after school starts back.
- There will be different levels of prizes; the best prizes require a BINGO Blackout (Completing EVERY square!)

Students are then to choose any other book to read. **PLEASE NOTE:** The required book and the book of choice will have a *GRADED* activity that the student will complete at the beginning of the school year. The students will need to have their books in hand when school begins in August.
