Tuition news: The rising cost of inflation has negatively impacted our budgets over the past several years and through hard work and good planning we've been able to continue our goal of maintaining a tuition schedule well below our sister schools. Recently our committee reviewed the upcoming school year and recognized the need to increase our tuition fees to meet the demands of the 2024-2025 academic school year. The tuition increase will ensure our ability to meet our budget goals as we guard our ability to remain comfortably below other private schools in the area while maintaining the highest level of excellence for our students, families and faculty. The new fee schedule is attached to the salmon colored re-enrollment paper that will be sent home tomorrow. The tuition and fee schedule will also be on our website. Thank you for partnering with us and for understanding the need for this fee increase.



REQUEST FOR RE-ENROLLMENT FORMS

Forms will be sent home with students Pre-K through 8th grade tomorrow, January 18th.

Forms will be emailed to parents/guardians of 9th – 11th graders. Ask your child(ren) for the re-enrollment forms.

Re-enrollment *for* Next School Year

Please return your request by Thursday, January 25th.
Please keep the tuition and fee schedule for your records.

Please **do not** send enrollment fees with **your request** for paperwork.

Enrollment paperwork **will be sent** home Thursday, February 1st.

Enrollment fees **are due** when you **return**
the enrollment paperwork **NOT** with
the Re-Enrollment Request Form.

At the time of enrollment, you may pay 1/3 of the enrollment fee.
The second 1/3 will be due by March 31st.
The final 1/3 will due by April 30th.

If you need tuition assistance forms, please check the box on the Re-Enrollment Request form that you would like a packet sent home with the re-enrollment paperwork.
Tuition assistance is only available for kinder through 12th grade.

Enrollment Reminder: Have your paperwork in by the end of February to have your name put into a drawing for your FIRST month of tuition free.

Dress Code Update for Upper School Girls

With the introduction of extremely cold temperatures, this winter and some heating challenges in some classrooms, we see a need to help our young ladies who wear uniform skirts stay warm. Starting today, when the outside temperature is below 50 degrees, upper school girls who are wearing uniform skirts are permitted to wear white or navy thermal leggings with their uniform skirt. They may also bring one (1) "individual" throw or blanket, no larger than 5 feet by 5 feet to use to cover their legs during class. Students may not share blankets and blankets must be stowed in their backpack or locker when not in use.
