The Newsletters are **PACKED** with information. **Please read** each one from beginning to end.


Parents, you will receive this newsletter weekly via the current email you have provided to the school office or you may access the newsletter on our school website (www.fbauc.org)

A few important reminders to keep everyone safe:


Please allow cars coming from the back gate to merge into carpool

LUNCH REMINDERS

Modest swimsuit (no 2 piece for girls, or wear t-shirt over)


Water bottle (there will be water cooler stations to refill)


Students CANNOT bring electronic devices such as radios, MP3s, PlayStations, video/audio equipment, etc., do not bring expensive jewelry.




There is no school or ELS on Monday, September 1st.
