Accessing FACTS Family Portal

FACTS gives you the opportunity to get more involved in your child's academic progress and future success by using FACTS Family Portal, a private and secure portal that allows you to view academic information specific to your children, while protecting their information from others. You may view your child's grades, attendance, homework, conduct, as well as other useful school information.

How to Access FACTS Family Portal:

- 3. Click Create Account.
- 4. Type your Email Address.
- Click CREATE ACCOUNT. An email will be sent which includes a link to create your Family Portal Login. The link is active for 6 hours.
- Click the Create your Family Portal Login link in the email.
- 7. Type a Username and Password.
- 8. Click Create Account.
- Click Back to log in and use your new credentials to log in.

Setting Parent Alerts In FACTS

If you would like to customize the type/frequency of student progress reports sent from FACTS you can change your preferences in the Family section of the

homepage. Select Family Home, then select the pencil symbol on the top right corner of the preferences box. Scroll down to the area that shows the Custodial Parents and select the Custodial Parent Form button. Each parent has the ability to customize their individual preferences. When the form opens you'll need to scroll to the bottom where you'll see the customize buttons. You can select the frequency of gradebook alerts at the top of the list (Never/Daily/Weekly) and turn on/off the information you would like to share in the directory on the website.
