### **STUDENT SAFETY**

It has been brought to our attention that we've had some 6th - 10th grade students leaving campus to go to fast food/beverage businesses after morning sports practice or after school before they're picked up.

**ALSO, some students wanting to watch an upcoming game are not being picked up at carpool. Students MAY NOT hang out in the gym or anywhere else on campus unsupervised. The gym is only open to spectators 15 minutes before start time. If outside this time frame, students MUST be picked up and then dropped off before the game starts **OR** they MUST go to Hangtime or ELS AND then released to the gym with parent permission.**

FBA is a closed campus from 6:30 am - 6:00 pm. Students must remain on campus after they've been dropped off in the morning until they are picked up after school unless they have a permission to sign-out sheet on file (11th/12th Grade Students only) or their parents have notified the office of an appointment or approved excuse to leave during the school day. Leaving campus without permission is considered a truancy. More specific details are included in the Parent Student Handbook pages 36 and 37.


