### Finding Your Child's Texas Student UID Number

A 10-digit Texas Student Unique ID (UID) is required for the voucher system for students with an IEP or FIIE for the application. Below is how you may obtain the UID number.

#### Option 1: State Website

Click the hyperlink labeled "Website to find out your child's UID number."

Select Student Look Up and enter your child's name, date of birth, and Social Security number to retrieve the UID.

#### Option 2: FIIE or IEP

Look for your child's local student ID number on their FIIE or IEP.

Add zeros to the beginning until it equals 10 digits, then enter it on the lookup site.

This will prompt you to enter your child's Social Security number, which will generate the official 10-digit UID.

If the above steps do not work, then you will need to contact the school district for the number.

Once you have this number save it for future use.
