A \$25.00 deposit is required when the form is returned.

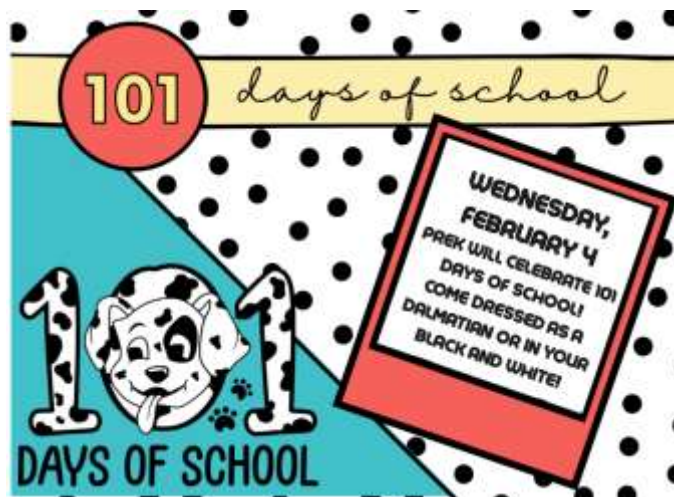

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are excited to announce that **online enrollment for the 2026–2027 school year** will open on **January 30th** for all current families (**excluding students entering 9th grade which have a separate process**).

To make the process simpler and more convenient, we will **no longer be sending home paper enrollment packets**. All enrollment will now be completed **online through Praxi**.

How to Complete Online Enrollment

Please follow these steps beginning January 30th:

1. Log in to Praxi (Please use a desktop as the App does not have this option)
2. Select Online Forms from the top banner
3. Choose the student you are enrolling
(This process must be completed for each student in your family.)
4. Under Select Form, choose the Enrollment Form for the 2026–2027 school year
5. Complete all required forms and submit payment
6. Once you hit confirm on payment screen, please choose process and submit form
(Disregard “please wait” submitting data – this is not referencing the payment portion)

Payment Information

- One-third (1/3) of the enrollment fee is due at the time of online enrollment
(You can pay more by adjusting the minimum amount)
(The remaining two one-third (1/3) payments will be due in March and April)
- Preschool families: a \$40 school supply fee is added in the shopping cart automatically

Extended Learning Services (ELS)

Families requesting Extended Learning Services (ELS) must:

- Follow the same process above but select the ELS Registration Form
- Submit the full ELS enrollment fee at the time of enrollment

Important Reminder

Please note that a student’s name will not be added to the class roster until all required online enrollment forms are completed and all required fees are submitted. You will receive a confirmation email for each student to include a separate one for ELS once your student has been accepted.

If you have any questions or need assistance with Praxi, our school office will be happy to help. Thank you for your continued partnership—we look forward to another great school year!

The TEFA program enrollment opening is next Wednesday, February 4th. It will remain open until March 17th. Families will be notified of selection starting in early April and initial funding (25%) will be available on July 1st. The remaining funds will be available on October 1st (50%) and April 1st 2027 (25%).

We encourage all families to apply. Please see details below.



TEFA Applications to Open Feb. 4

On Feb. 4, we will launch parent applications for Texas Education Freedom Accounts (TEFA).

Take your time! Applications will be open until March 17.

The TEFA program is not first come, first served. A student who applies on Feb. 4 will be treated the same as one who applies on March 17 — or any date in between.

Three Steps to Get Ready

1. **Gather your documents.** Our [checklist](#) outlines everything you will need to apply.
2. **Decide if you will homeschool or enroll your child in an accredited private school.** Search participating schools with our [finder tool](#).
3. **If applicable, confirm your child's disability.** If your child has an eligible disability, your application may qualify for priority. If you do not have a current Individualized Education Program (IEP), we can confirm application priority with other documents:
 - An older IEP or an IEP completed in another state.
 - A Full and Individual Initial Evaluation (FIIE) form confirming an eligible disability.
 - Now available: A [Disability Certification Form \(PDF\)](#) signed by a licensed practitioner.

Note: *Your child also may qualify for additional funding based on the special education services identified in their IEP. To qualify, a current IEP must be on file with the Texas Education Agency.*

Don't see your favorite school? Don't worry. We're adding new schools each week. You'll have until later this summer to confirm your child's school. All you need to do on your application is tell us if you intend to enroll them in a participating, accredited private school. That allows them to qualify for the maximum funding amount.

Come Out and Meet Us!

Our team and partner organizations are hosting sessions across the state to share the latest information and help with your application.

Many events also will feature the opportunity to meet local schools and learn if they might be right for your child.
